

***Passion Week Consecration 2026
Prayer and Study Points***

Dear Bethel Family and Friends,

Here is some important information for you to consider as we embark on this special week of fasting and prayer.

Fasting Instructions

**Fast begins Sunday, March 29, 2026 at 9:00 PM
thru Friday, April 3, 2026 at 12:00 NOON**

Bare minimum is the **Daniel Fast** which includes:

Fruits * Nuts * Vegetables
No Caffeine and No Fish (do your best)
No Dessert, No Soda, No Sweets (except breath mints)
(Adjust accordingly if medication is a concern)

Options also include:

- One meal a day (your pick) – no dessert, soda or sweets except breath mints.
- Fasting with water only (if not the full five days then on selected days combined with Daniel Fast or one meal in the day) broth and tea permissible.

The schedule for fasting is intentional in allowing for consideration to **FASTING SOCIAL MEDIA IN FAVOR OF IN-PERSON FELLOWSHIP AMONG THE PEOPLE OF GOD**. Most of Palm Sunday, and then the balance of Good Friday and Saturday is left open to pursue meaningful interaction among the saints around the subject matter you will discover in the Prayer and Study plan for this Passion week.

Let's walk in great expectation of what God will do in our midst.

Sunday, March 29, 2026 – Night Prayer

Looking beyond the current challenge we are facing locally and globally- we are going to lift up the name of Jesus!! Who is our great God and Savior Jesus Christ? How did He show His greatness to you from January until now?? How about for someone else or something else beyond yourself - where you said “ look at God”? How many situations can you name?

Record it! Rehearse it in His ears!

Next - what is the major challenge you are facing right now- and what biblical personality can you identify with that God blessed in a manner resulting in praise?

Now Praise Him for that

Then read and meditate on that passage and ask God to promote your faith to that level believing Him for your change to come.

But wait!..... Before you go to bed there is more:

Prayer over the Sanctuary – Fruitfulness

Hebrews 13:15: *Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.*


1 Chronicles 16:23-26 NLT *Let the whole earth sing to the Lord! Each day proclaim the good news that he saves. Publish his glorious deeds among the nations. Tell everyone about the amazing things he does. Great is the Lord! He is most worthy of praise! He is to be feared above all gods. The gods of other nations are mere idols, but the Lord made the heavens!*

Planting for the Promise

Luke 8:15 *But the seed on good soil stands for those with a noble and good heart, who hear the word, retain it, and by persevering produce a crop.*

Revelation 7:9-10 ESV *After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, and crying out with a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!*

Begin the consecration by FOCUSING ON YOUR OWN PRAISE TO THE LORD while reflecting on the Worship and Word from Sunday service(s). Then pray that it finds good ground and comes to fruition in the lives of the hearers. Pray especially that it begins in your own life as you continue to be poised to both spread His Word but also be willing to take the risk in defending His Word before all people groups – as the Lord directs. End your night with Praise!



Passion Week Consecration 2026 Prayer and Study Points

Monday, March 30, 2026

Continuing from last night – as TODAY we will focus on TAKING TERRITORIES by putting PRAISE INTO PRACTICE. We will adjust and inform our inner person by addressing scriptures representing 3 action points.

REFOCUS - by locking in on the Words of Jesus detailing his expectation and Paul’s imperative that we follow through via self-reflection.

John 15:16 ESV *You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you.*

Romans 12:2 *Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.*

Find suitable time of SOLITUDE to sum up the areas that require your effort towards renewal of your thought life as well as evaluating the measure of “fruitfulness” resident in your walk as a servant and friend of God. Do so with the assistance of our God as it states in:

Psalms 139:23 *“Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts.”*

Even as we acknowledge...

Romans 8:6 *The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace.*

RECONCILE - After following through on the above – don’t give place to the enemy who is intent in beating us up and discouraging us from attempting to reach higher ground in our walk with God. As Bishop Dale Bronner shared in a recent meeting “there is always a voice in the Void” – and so even as the enemy is trying right now to show you how “empty” your efforts have been – remember that is what this Passion season is all about. We praise HIM because of how His crucifixion STACKS UP in the face of our LACK.

Colossians 1:21-22 *And you, who once were alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.*

On this basis we are not to be denied the commission we receive by His blood. Praise God you have your own ordination certificate – “Minister of Reconciliation.” Meditate for a while on what that means where you are presently planted!


2 Corinthians 5:18-21 - *All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people’s sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ’s ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ’s behalf: Be reconciled to God. God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.*

So, what strategies can you ask HIM for to execute your assignment? What can you do in the RIGHT NOW?

RECOVER – As you continue to worship and Praise Him for the privilege of ordination know that your praise is genuine as it is founded on the strength of your connection to the provider through prayer. Pray in the confidence of Jeremiah – even as HIS CRUCIFIXION was not a vain act but rather one that was executed to meet each of us at the point of our need.

Jeremiah 17:14 *Heal me, O Lord, and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, For You are my praise.*

Isaiah 58:11 *And the Lord will continually guide you, And satisfy your desire in scorched places, And give strength to your bones; And you will be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water whose waters do not fail.*



Passion Week Consecration 2026 Prayer and Study Points

Tuesday, March 31, 2026

Body ministry – what would Jesus have us to do as we renew our sense of calling?

Relaunch - Today you will ask God to give you 3 individuals that you will commit to prayer (write it all down). You will ask God – through your HOLY GHOST connection - to show you at least one thing for each person representing a miraculous divine intervention in their life. The Crucifixion was our entre to a new level of authority – discernment and conquest over the work of the usurper. As you continue to consecrate – stretch your faith and trust God to use you to impact lives on a new level.


Please note – don't be afraid if you fail to have visible signs of a shift or immediate fruit in your intercession. It is a process but also an adventure. How exciting to see what God will do through the power He has vested in you.

***Acts 1:8 ESV** But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.*

***John 12:31-32 ESV** Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.*

Intercede throughout the day... and in addition pray to God regarding one person who you will invite to be your share partner as we bring this consecration to a close. Remember, the person you chose might also have another person in mind as well... so be open to expanding this into a cluster of 3 to 4 individuals.

Make those spirit led connections by the end of day and prepare to follow the instructions as we outline them.

Wednesday, April 1, 2026

On this day we continue in our quest for deep revelation through Prayer – Praise – Proclamation!
Today we focus in on empowerment for:


Liberating Transformation – Review all that we have done since Sunday (reread and rehearse all that you have expressed through prayer, study and writing). Give God thanks for bringing you into a “PLEASANT PLACE” even as you acknowledge that there are persistent and pressing needs in your own life as well as those for whom you are interceding. Read the TEXT:

***2 Kings 2:19-21** Then the men of the city said to Elisha, “Behold now, the situation of this city is pleasant, as my lord sees; but the water is bad and the land is unfruitful.” He said, “Bring me a new jar, and put salt in it.” So they brought it to him. He went out to the spring of water and threw salt in it and said, “Thus says the Lord, ‘I have purified these waters; there shall not be from there death or unfruitfulness any longer.’”*

Today you will acknowledge and wait before God as representative of the “New Jar” that has been salted these three days – even as God will use you and your fellow intercessors to proceed to do spiritual warfare for the territories for which you are praying.

Spend much of the day PRAISING GOD for choosing and empowering you for His service and be attentive to unique opportunities that He is going to give this day to supernaturally be an answer to someone’s need. When it happens be sure to record it for what is to come over the last two days.

(Be sure to rehearse again all that you have been doing since Sunday)

Thursday, April 2, 2026

Intercession –

*Matthew 26:36 -38 (NASB) Then Jesus *came with them to a place called [a]Gethsemane, and *told His disciples, “Sit here while I go over there and pray.” And He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee with Him, and began to be grieved and distressed. Then He *said to them, “My soul is deeply grieved, to the point of death; remain here and keep watch with Me.”*


On this night of betrayal and failure – the suffering Servant of Isaiah 49: 1-12, Isaiah 52: 13 - 53:12 went into the garden to pray. One of the lessons in the text is the power of unity in prayer. What Jesus **HIGHLIGHTS** we must always keep in the **HEADLIGHTS** ... and so today we find time to connect within our prayer clusters. Today you will open up your intercession throughout the day – (use your own creativity to make it happen – technology is in your hand) to pray generally for:

MEMBERSHIP – your fellow sisters and brothers in the body -especially where the need is generally known. And then you will prayer for:

LEADERSHIP -even as your Leaders have been and are praying for the body of Christ – your prayers will be linked to theirs in a show of strength before the enemy of our souls. Then you will end with praying for those that represent leadership in the body.

Then from that position of strength we will pray for the global enterprise – the nations and people groups in our neighborhoods, our country and around the World. We will pray for outreach ministries, and those who have yet to even hear the message of salvation. We will all pray in a time and place you have designated as the Spirit will lead.

Finally – pray collectively (without names unless necessary and appropriate) for the 3 individuals that God has laid on your heart since the start of the consecration. Give God thanks for answered Prayer.



Passion Week Consecration 2026 Prayer and Study Points

Friday, April 3, 2026

(Fast ends at NOON – but feel free to share throughout the day.)

IT IS FINISHED!

John 19:28-30 After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, “I thirst!” Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth. So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

Seek out your prayer partners and spend time in praise and thanksgiving for not only the sacrificial death of our Lord and Savior but also what you have personally gained through our time of consecration during this passion week. It is finished – was the declaration that all that we needed to secure the victory of personal salvation and our commissioning had been established. As such we have been cleared by our creator to follow our precious savior as “INTO HIS HANDS” he commended His Spirit.

Share as specific as you feel is wise – just what God revealed to you during this time as well as any praise reports coming out of the intercession for others.

Give Him all the honor glory and praise as you conclude this 2026 Passion Week season of Consecration – (consecrated for His service for this week and beyond)!
